Training is provided, so while direct guiding experience is a bonus, if you have a passion for NFL, people and the relevant skills and have good availability throughout October being a Visitor Attraction NFL Tour Guide with us could be the role for you.

JOB PURPOSE

Visitor Attraction NFL Tour Guides are responsible for a world class fan and visitor experience, delivering the NFL stadium tour and all aspects of the experience including, ticketing, photography, and preparation of the tour areas.

- Develop and maintain knowledge of NFL and Tottenham Hotspur Stadium and Tottenham Experience and to be an ambassador for the Tottenham Hotspur all stakeholders.
- Operate ticketing systems, selling tickets, amending bookings, and checking visitors into the tour.
- Operate photography equipment throughout the tour taking pictures of visitors throughout key locations.
- Generate revenue and achieve sales targets through upselling photo packages, tickets, merchandise and promoting the visitor attractions.
- Ensure the tour route and visitor attractions are presented to the highest standard, clear of litter, clutter and anything that could detract from the experience.
- To promote and advise on other products including retail, ticketing, hospitality.
- To carry out other related duties that may be reasonably requested.
- Responsible for the safety and security of all visitors throughout the visitor attractions including evacuating groups in an emergency.
